**1. GERMANE (ADJECTIVE):** *appropriate*

*Synonyms: applicable, apropos*

*Antonyms: inappropriate, irrelevant*

*Example Sentence:*

*His germane approach hit the nail on the head.*

**2. REGIMEN (NOUN):** *systematic plan*

*Synonyms: procedure, regime*

*Antonyms: unsystematic, disorder*

*Example Sentence:*

*The chief devised a regimen.*

**3. EMPATHIC (ADJECTIVE):** *by proxy*

*Synonyms: delegated, deputed*

*Antonyms: indifferent, unfeeling*

*Example Sentence:*

*Being an empathic person he donated eyes.*

**4. QUIP (NOUN):** *A clever remark*

*Synonyms: banter, gag*

*Antonyms: praise, flattery*

*Example Sentence:*

*Vini made a quip at her opponent.*

**5. OPULENCE (NOUN):** *wealth*

*Synonyms: affluence, lavishness*

*Antonyms: dearth, poverty*

*Example Sentence:*

*He has seen opulence since childhood.*

**6. RAMPART (NOUN):** *defensive wall*

*Synonyms: barricade, fortification*

*Antonyms: depression, ditch*

*Example Sentence:*

*The palace was constructed with a rampart.*

**7. HIDEOUS (ADJECTIVE):** *horrible*

*Synonyms: appalling, awful*

*Antonyms: pleasant, lovable*

*Example Sentence:*

*The director wanted to make some hideous movie.*

**8. DILEMMA (NOUN):** *quandary*

*Synonyms: in a fix, predicament*

*Antonyms: advantage, good fortune*

*Example Sentence:*

*Garima was in a dilemma when the panel asked her a question regarding her future plans.*

**9. QUINTESSENCE (NOUN):** *perfect example*

*Synonyms: paragon, ideal*

*Antonyms: artificial, copy*

*Example Sentence:*

*Green tea is a quintessence of herbal remedy.*

**10. IRREDUCIBLE (ADJECTIVE):** *profiting*

*Synonyms: exclusive, final*

*Antonyms: unprofiting, unclear*

*Example Sentence:*

*He made an irreducible business plan.*
