

1. LOWKEY (ADJECTIVE): *subdued*

Synonyms: laid-back, muted Antonyms: agitated, noisy

Example Sentence:

Manmohan's government was a lowkey one.

2. AMENABLE (ADJECTIVE): *agreeable*

Synonyms: responsive, susceptible Antonyms: irresponsible, intractable

Example Sentence:

The judgement was passed by the amenable committee.

3. TRANSITORY (ADJECTIVE): *temporary*

Synonyms: momentary, transient Antonyms: lasting, permanent

Example Sentence:

This opposition is transitory.

4. ENTRENCHED (ADJECTIVE): *rooted*

Synonyms: fixed, fortified Antonyms: irresolute, indefinite

Example Sentence:

These moral values are entrenched in her behaviour.

5. INTREPID (ADJECTIVE): *brave*

Synonyms: fearless, heroic Antonyms: afraid, fearful

Example Sentence:

You are an intrepid girl!

6. STIPULATE (VERB): *decide on conditions*

Synonyms: lay down, impose Antonyms: refuse, decline

Example Sentence:

The ruling government will stipulate the impunity to criminals.

7. ANTITHESIS (NOUN): *exact opposite*

Synonyms: contra, contrast Antonyms: same, similarity

Example Sentence:

His theory was an utter antithesis to the previous one.

8. JOVIAL (ADJECTIVE): *fun-loving*

Synonyms: jolly, hearty Antonyms: apathetic, lethargic

Example Sentence:

She is literally very much jovial person by heart.

9. ABASE (VERB): *be little*

Synonyms: debase, degrade Antonyms: upgrade, praise

Example Sentence:

He abased his elder brother.

10. RECIPROCITY (NOUN): *interchange*

Synonyms: exchange, mutuality Antonyms: difference, disconnection

Example Sentence:

A relationship will eventually begin to feel one-sided without reciprocity.
