1. UNRULY (ADJECTIVE): Loud

Synonyms: boisterous, noisy

Antonyms: quite, silent

Example Sentence:

The unruly activists belonged to ABC political party.

2. BRADE (VERB): to be angry

Synonyms: irritate, chafe

Antonyms: soothe, appease

Example Sentence:

He was braded over such a trivial issue.

3. OBSEQUIOUS (ADJECTIVE): Submissive

Synonyms: complacent, abject

Antonyms: arrogant, brazen

Example Sentence:

Some members of his team are pretty much obsequious.

4. AGGRIEVED (ADJECTIVE): Disturbed

Synonyms: oppressed, wronged

Antonyms: comforted, pleased

Example Sentence:

Aggrieved family of the martyr paid last tribute to his dear body.

5. CONGREGATE (VERB): Assemble

Synonyms: collect, gather

Antonyms: disperse, distribute

Example Sentence:

The crowd congregated amid drizzle to celebrate international Yoga day.

6. IMPECUNIOUS (ADJECTIVE): Poverty-Stricken

Synonyms: penniless, poor Antonyms: wealthy, rich

Example Sentence:

I wonder why only impecunious people are dominated by the upper middle class.

7. ALLEGIANCE (NOUN): loyalty

Synonyms: dedication, adherence Antonyms: apathy, dishonour

Example Sentence:

The party proved its allegiance to the public.

8. WOEFUL (ADJECTIVE): Miserable

Synonyms: anguished, calamitous Antonyms: cheery, hopeful

Example Sentence:

Due to woeful state of his job his family is hand to mouth.

9. SMIRK (VERB): smile coyly

Synonyms: sneer, simper Antonyms: frown, cry

Example Sentence:

The little girl smirked over her pet's activities.

10. DIMINUTIVE (ADJECTIVE): small and weak

Synonyms: inconsequential, puny Antonyms: giant, mammoth

Example sentence:

The baby took very diminutive steps.
