

The Hindu Vocabulary - 07.07.2017

1. SUNDRY (ADJECTIVE): *Miscellaneous*

Synonyms: assorted, manifold

Antonyms: individual, singular

Example Sentence:

For all his minor sundry crimes he was sent to coventry by the society.

2. SHRILL (ADJECTIVE): *Discordant*

Synonyms: noisy, strident

Antonyms: calm, mild

Example Sentence:

The sound of the shrill whistle made everyone stand still.

3. SOOT (NOUN): *Grime*

Synonyms: grit, residue

Antonyms: cleanliness, neatness

Example Sentence:

I was ready to go out but soot over my shoes really threw the spanner in the works.

4. STRIDE (VERB): *Stalk*

Synonyms: stomp, tramp

Antonyms: stagger, tiptoe

Example Sentence:

As restaurant is on the 2nd floor I decided to stride than to use a lift.

5. SPARTAN (ADJECTIVE): Austere

Synonyms: arduous, rigid

Antonyms: fancy, adorned

Example Sentence:

His new Spartan business plan proved to be a damp squib.

6. PEPPY (ADJECTIVE): Full of spirit

Synonyms: lively, playful

Antonyms: depressed, down

Example Sentence:

He is a peppy person.

7. SIDESTEP (VERB): Dodge

Synonyms: avoid, evade

Antonyms: face, confront

Example Sentence:

Sidestepping a weary question is a piece of cake for the actors.

8. UNALLOYED (ADJECTIVE): Absolute

Synonyms: bona fide, legitimate

Antonyms: dubious, unsure

Example Sentence:

This very little child has unalloyed feelings towards everybody.

9. TABOO (ADJECTIVE): Forbidden

Synonyms: outlawed, prohibited

Antonyms: acceptable, mentionable

Example Sentence:

The gourmet chef considers any dish made from canned goods to be taboo.

10. STIGMA (NOUN): Scar

Synonyms: stain, blemish

Antonyms: exaltation, benefit

Example Sentence:

His sitting idle for hours in office put stigma over his image.
