

1. EMERGE (VERB): develop

Synonyms: appear, arrive

Antonyms: abandon, decrease

Example sentence:

Big cows emerged from the fog.

2. TAME (ADJECTIVE): docile

Synonyms: mild, subdued

Antonyms: harsh, rough

Example sentence:

It is a tame dog.

3. UNACCEPTABLE (ADJECTIVE): undesirable

Synonyms: objectionable, offensive

Antonyms: acceptable, agreeable

Example sentence:

This kind of behaviour is unacceptable.

4. REVEAL (VERB): disclose

Synonyms: unveil, expose

Antonyms: conceal, hide

Example sentence:

She revealed the secret.

5. ALLY (ADJECTIVE): associate

Synonyms: partner, accomplice

Antonyms: antagonist, foe

Example sentence:

He is my business ally.

6. ENTIRELY (ADVERB): completely

Synonyms: fully, solely

Antonyms: partly, partially

Example sentence:

This process is entirely different.

7. EMINENT (ADJECTIVE): well known

Synonyms: esteemed, distinguished

Antonyms: insignificant, inferior

Example sentence:

He is an eminent linguist.

8. APPEAL (NOUN): claim

Synonyms: bid, request

Antonyms: revocation, disclaimer

Example sentence:

She appealed in the court.

9. CONSENSUS (NOUN): accord

Synonyms: concord, consent

Antonyms: discord, disagreement

Example sentence:

They signed a consensus.

10. TWIST (NOUN): curve

Synonyms: arc, bend

Antonyms: straight, line

Example sentence:

They are talking with an interesting twist.
