

1. ASSISTANCE (NOUN): aid

Synonyms: help, support

Antonyms: damage, hindrance

Example sentence:

It requires your assistance.

2. UNFORTUNATELY (ADVERB): unluckily

Synonyms: sadly, disastrously

Antonyms: fortunately, luckily

Example sentence:

She fell into the well unfortunately.

3. HEAVY (ADJECTIVE): arduous

Synonyms: burdensome, onerous

Antonyms: easy, facile

Example sentence:

This is a heavy duty.

4. PRONE (NOUN): prostrate

Synonyms: reclining, supine

Antonyms: unlikely, upright

Example sentence:

This is an accident-prone area.

5. ENSURE (VERB): guarantee

Synonyms: assure, insure

Antonyms: harm, injure

Example sentence:

The company ensures to refund your money.

6. PARTIAL (ADJECTIVE): incomplete

Synonyms: limited, imperfect

Antonyms: total, entire

Example sentence:

Why are you taking partial judgement?

7. DRAINING (ADJECTIVE): tiring

Synonyms: exhausting, fatiguing

Antonyms: easy, untroubling

Example sentence:

I hate this draining activity of mine.

8. INSULATE (VERB): isolate

Synonyms: seclude, sequester

Antonyms: join, mingle

Example sentence:

To get insulate is not a good idea.

9. DANGER (NOUN): crisis

Synonyms: insecurity, risk

Antonyms: safety, security

Example sentence:

These open manholes are the source of danger in the localities.

10. ATTENTION (NOUN): concentration

Synonyms: consideration, mind

Antonyms: disregard, laziness

Example sentence:

Please pay attention!
