

1. DISPENSATION (NOUN): disbursement

Synonyms: allotment, conferment

Antonyms: denial, disfavour

Example sentence:

Mridul was given special dispensation to play before her birthday.

2. INCONGRUITY (NOUN): mismatch

Synonyms: incongruousness, incompatibility **Antonyms:** congruence, congruity

Example sentence:

The teacher smiled at the incongruity of the question.

3. MANDATED (ADJECTIVE): administered

Synonyms: authorized, authorized

Antonyms: illegal, unlawful

Example sentence:

The rightful king was mandated and sanctioned by God.

4. TRANSPARENCY (NOUN): pellucidness

Synonyms: clarity, clearness

Antonyms: opacity, opaqueness

Example sentence:

I relish watching transparency of ice.

5. TEMPORARILY (ADVERB): transiently

Synonyms: briefly, transitorily

Antonyms: permanently, for good

Example sentence:

The doctor said that symptoms may disappear temporarily.

6. STRINGENT (ADJECTIVE): rigid

Synonyms: draconian, binding

Antonyms: lenient, flexible

Example sentence:

Stringent guidelines on air pollution were given.

7. INTENTION (NOUN): purpose

Synonyms: motive, aim

Antonyms: discouragement, aimlessness

Example sentence:

Srishti was full of good intentions.

8. MALPRACTICE (NOUN): dereliction

Synonyms: misdeed, violation, disobedience

Antonyms: behaviour,

Example sentence:

These are the victims of medical malpractice.

9. ACCESSIBILITY (NOUN): approachability

Synonyms: convenience, openness

Antonyms: unapproachability, inconvenience

Example sentence:

The restoration project involved improving accessibility.

10. REPEATEDLY (ADVERB): again

Synonyms: frequently, often **Antonyms:** seldom, rarely

Example sentence:

They have repeatedly denied the allegations.
