

## **Doctor Sapan Shah will fight for Congressional Congress**



- Indian doctor of Indian origin Sapan Shah will contest the US Congress next year.
- Shah, founder of Flagship Healthcare in Chicago, has announced that he will contest the House of Representatives for Republican candidate from Chicago's suburban area.
- Democratic leader Brad Schneider is currently representing this seat.
- Shah, who is preparing to compete in the 2018 election, will have to register a primary win in March next year for the party ticket.

#### India's first batsmen to score 100 runs in the ODIs



- Team India captain Virat Kohli 's unbeaten innings of 160 runs in the third one-dayer against South Africa was very special in many ways.
- Virat scored 12 boundaries and two sixes in this innings.
- That is, he made 60 runs with four fours and ran 100 runs.
- In this way Virat became the first batsmen of India to score 100 runs in an ODI innings.

#### Dhoni records new record in ODIs



- India defeated South Africa by 124 runs in the third ODI of Cape Town.
- In the match, former team captain MS Dhoni did two hunt behind the wicket and got a big record in his name.
- He has become the fourth wicketkeeper in India's first ODI and the fourth wicketkeeper in the ODIs, behind more than 400 wickets behind the wicket.

## South China Sea is becoming a military outpost of China




- China has invested many years in preparing a military outpost on the islands of South China Sea.
