SSC CGL Exam Analysis 2018 Tier 1 (All Shifts) | June 04, 2019

SSC CGL Exam Analysis for Tier 1 on the first day basically concludes that SSC CGL maintains its difficulty level and also the pattern as per the last conducted year.

Student's review about SSC CGL 2018 was expectedly similar. Everyone reviews the exam to be of moderate difficulty.

- Overall good attempts for the exam are **69-76 questions.**
- English was easy in the exam with no passage in the first shift while the other two shifts included the passage.
- Quant/Maths section was not much difficult however, it was the most time-consuming. The questions required calculations.
- The reasoning was also amongst the easy sections of the exam with most questions from the previous year question papers for SSC CGL
- GK was more tricky as compared to the expectations. It was tough as mentioned by students. Questions from Current Affairs before 2019 were asked.

Ans. There are 100 objective type questions asked in SSC CGL Tier 1. The exam has questions divided into different sections. They are distributed in specific sections according to the following exam pattern:

- General Awareness- 25 questions
- General Intelligence and Reasoning- 25 questions
- Quantitative Aptitude- 25 questions
- English- 25 questions

Ques. What is SSC CGL Exam?

Ans. SSC CGL exam is a recruitment exam to various posts in the Staff Selection Commission. The total vacancies for SSC CGL 2018 are approximately 8089. Every year lakhs of candidates appear for this exam to secure a govt. job.
